

Sabers Win Thankgiving Day Bowl 35-21





Sabers First Indoor Track and Field Meet This Saturday at Dartmouth


Souhegan track and field coaches John Eastman, Cathy Merra, and Jeff Wilson welcomed approximately thirty track and field athletes to the indoor track program at the first day of practice on Monday, November 30.

The boys' team features several returning competitors from last year's Class I Meet. Senior Mike aided by veteran seniors Grant Raymond and Matt Chareth, both in the 600 meters and relays. Junior Parker Hall returns to the 300 meters and the relays, and sophomore returnees include Bert DeForest (1500 and relays), Aaron Prescott (300 and relays) and Jim Velino (1000 meters). Sophomore James Tabor will put the shot and juniors Harrison CaThe girls' team also has several people returning from last winter's Class Meet. Sophomore Isabella Stuopis was fourth in the shot and should do even better this winter. Seniors Laura Tebbetts (55 meters and sprint relay), Molly Mirhashem(600 and long relay), Arianne Bennett(long relay), and Hillary Wilson (600 and long relay) are also veterans of the Class Meets and should continue to improve. Other senior veterans are Andrea Griffin(sprints), Chelsea Kelly (sprints) and Rachel Konkler (hurdles). Junior Kelsey Knight was eighth in the 55 meter hurdles in last winter's Class


