In a field of 14 teams, the Souhegan Sabers finished fifth with 616 points behind first place Kennett (774.5), Plymouth second (749.5), Bedford third (637) and in fourth place, Hollis Brookline with 630 points. Milford (433) came in

Ben Lambert of Milford grabbed fifth place in giant slalom with a combined two-run time of 68.12.

MANCHESTER – The Derryfield School's swim team competed in the NH Division 2 Swimming Championships held at UNH on Saturday, Feb. 13, with 25 other high schools, including Bedford, Hollis-Brookline, Milford, and Souhegan. Not only did Derryfield's boys medley relay team qualify to compete again the very next day in the New Hampshire Meet of Champions, but their excellent performance there earned them the opportunity to represent New Hampshire in the New England Meet of Champions scheduled for Feb. 27 in the same pool.

At the Div. 2 State meet, the Derryfield boys 200-yard (4x50) medley relay team finished 3rd, behind 1st-place Souhegan and 2nd-place Bedford, out of 12 teams of which 4 were DQ. Senior Kendall Kaspar (of Windham) swam the backstroke leg; junior Hunter Holbrook (Amherst) breaststroke; junior Ian Will (Mont Vernon) butterfly; and senior Alexander Seiger (Concord) freestyle. At the Meet of Champions, they raced even better and placed 3rd again, this time in a field of 15 relay teams of the best of both Divisions 1 and 2,

behind Bishop Guertin in 1st place and Souhegan in 2nd.

They followed up with noteworthy individual swims. In the Div. championship meet, Hunter dropped 4 seconds off his qualifying time to place 8th (out of 15 competitors) in the 100-yard breaststroke. Ian, running a fever, placed 4th (of 16) in the 50-yard freestyle, and 5th in the 100-yard butterfly. Kendall finished 3rd (of 14) in the 100-yard freestyle and 8th (of 16) in the 200 free. Alex placed 8th in the 100 fly and 12th in the 100 free.

With top-9 finishes, they each qualified for the Meet of Champions and achieved respectable finishes there. Hunter shaved another whole second off his time. He credits Derryfield coach Jon Steer's training on technique for his significant improvement over the year. Kendall qualified for the New England Championship with his 6th place in the 100-yard freestyle on the second day.

The highlight for the Derryfield girls was 10th place finishes by Lucy Steer (of Nashua) in both the 200 and 500-yard freestyle events in the Div. 2 State meet.
