Bedard Qualifies for USA Swimming Junior Nationals

Congratulations to Alex Bedard of Amherst, who qualified for the USA Swimming Junior Nationals, which will be held this coming December in Federal Way, Washington. Bedard, a member of the Executive Swim Club, qualified in the 100 meter Breaststroke event swimming a 1:07.36. The qualifying time was achieved at the recent New England Swimming Senior Championships, held July 18-20 at Brown University in Providence, R.I. Bedard swam personal best times in seven other events. In the 100 Breaststroke he finished fourth in a field of over 60 qualified swimmers. He also finaled in the 200 meter Breaststroke (2:35.31), and the 200 Individual Medley (2:16.19). Bedard trains with the Executive Swim Club in Manchester, NH. He will be a senior at Souhegan High School this fall.
