NHWHGC Wounded Heroes Golf Tournament on 9/11 Benefited Semper Fi

AMHERST – Last April, Air Force veteran, Dick Lefebvre of Amherst, had an idea to put together a Golf Tournament on 9/11 to honor Wounded Heroes and their families. All proceeds went to Semper Fi, an organization dedicated to helping all branches of the military and their families.


Dick put together a committee that included Pete Eiche, Charlie Boncore, Rick St. Peter, Chuck Siragusa, Ken Peterson, George Scollin, and Casey Foulks, (Dick's grandson who was our Web Designer; U.S. Senator Kelly Ayotte and former Florida Governor Jeb Bush visited a display table on the 4th of July on the Amherst Town Green). The Committee initially met at Dick's house and continued to meet at the Amherst Library and the Amherst Fire Station.

As the months of planning went by; sponsors were contacted; volunteers were added to assist; Raffle Prizes were secured and auction items were donated. Steve Desmarais volunteered to be the auctioneer for the event. Then the reg-

istrations began to come in. The Tournament was **Sold Out** with over 150 golfers registered!

At the start of the event were two recruiters from each branch of the military standing at attention as Miss Londonderry, Miss Alaina Belanger, sang the Star Spangled Banner. Then the shotgun began. Among the prizes the golfers were competing for a trip to Pebble Beach for a Hole in One; a separate \$1000.00 prize for a Hole-in One on the 19th hole; 4 Dozen Golf Balls for Longest Drive/Closest to Pin, etc., Putting Contest; 50/50 competition on a Par 3; and other prizes; including cash prizes to 1st and 2nd place teams.

The committee also received over \$600.00 for Semper Fi from private individuals. Auction Items were: several drills from local merchants including Currier Lumber; gift baskets; certificates to several golf courses for a round for 4 golfers; and many other wonderful prizes. In total; the auction, raffle and donations exceeded \$19,000.
